

LESSON PLAN TITLE:

## **Paper Mosaic**

MATERIALS:

Black paper, cut 8" x 8", scissors, variety of colored construction paper, pencils, eraser, glue.

OBJECTIVES:

Students will use fine and gross motor skills to cut and glue paper parts into small and medium shapes. Students will also develop understandings of organic and geometric shapes, as well as positive and negative space.

ANTICIPATORY SET (LEAD-IN, ACTIVATING PREVIOUS KNOWLEDGE, "HOOK"):

Slide presentation of ceramic and glass mosaic tile work. Teacher's example and demonstration.

STEP-BY-STEP PROCEDURE:

1. Students will draw a singular design on black paper.
2. Students will cut out several rectangles, squares and triangles and place them together inside areas of drawing.
3. Upon gluing shapes into drawing, students will leave slight black area of construction paper exposed in between shapes. Ultimately, a filled composition will result from all areas being filled in.
